

# BIPEA OFFERS A NEW PROFICIENCY TEST IN THE FIELD OF WINE

## ANALYSIS IN DEALCOHOLIZED WINES

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BIPEA has created a new Proficiency Testing Schemes (PT 17C) dedicated to wine testing. This quality control allows testing laboratories (and wine industries) to evaluate their analytical performance by analysing a sample of dealcoholized wine.

For this trial, BIPEA will propose a 750 ml dealcoholized wine sample. The parameters to be analysed are: physical, inorganic compounds, volatils compounds, organic acids, preservatives, and other compounds. When performing analysis on samples, participating laboratories are required to apply their routine methods.
